

The Campus



The Campus is the completion of a city district and the creation of a unique integrated business and social community. This community will thrive on the synergy of R&D and business, enhanced by the site's proximity to the new Masaryk University extension and Brno Teaching Hospital. This energy will be sustained by Campus Square - a new retail town center - expanded local public transport, sport and leisure facilities, and a new residential zone.

The Masaryk University Campus

The Masaryk University Campus in Brno – Bohunice, occupying almost 90,000 m² of utilizable floor space for teaching and research on a built-up area of 20 hectares, will, upon completion, become a new, modern, educational and research development base for Masaryk University. It will provide a base for the Faculty of Medicine and in part for the Faculty of Science as well as for the Faculty of Sport Studies. The new campus is designed to cater to 5,000 students and 1,000 university faculty members and research scientists.



The University Campus borders on the buildings of the Faculty Hospital in Brno as well as on the Moravian Provincial Archives and the Campus Square shopping center.

The campus comprises two distinct components:

- **ILBIT (Integrated Laboratories for Biomedical Technologies)**
- **AVVA (Academic Teaching and Research Complex)**



The programme for the construction of the new university campus includes the reconstruction and modernization of the Morphology Centre site, finished in 2004. The development of teaching and in particular biomedical research will support the surrounding areas and campus link with the Faculty Hospital in Brno.



The new botanical garden at the Faculty of Science will provide an esthetic dimension to the area. The entire investment in the construction of the university campus has from 2002 to 2008 already amounted about 5.1 bil. CZK.



Approximately 16 hectares of development property in the near surroundings of the site for the new university campus are intended to create a new urban center between 2006 and 2015, including supporting infrastructure for student residences, canteens, sport facilities, conference centers and space for leisure activities, as well as facilities related to business and commercial activities, particularly those of a developmental and innovative character.

Integrated Laboratories for Biomedical Technologies (ILBIT)

The construction of the university campus: launched in September 2004 with the building of the first four pavilions: A2, A3, A4, and A6 designated as ILBIT, the Integrated Laboratories for Biomedical Technologies.

- the laboratories: a technological base for research and development for the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Science
- the construction of the ILBIT: 730 mil. CZK; completed and opened in September 2005

Academic Teaching and Research Complex (AVVA)

The construction has been divided into three stages, commonly known as the Blue, Yellow and Green Stages.



Construction of the Blue Stage

The construction of the AVVA at the university campus was launched in December 2006 with the start of work on additional pavilions and academic department facilities for the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Science, as well as an informatics centre, all within the framework of the Blue Stage. The Blue Stage comprises the following twelve sites:

- Three pavilions for the Faculty of Medicine (biology A7, bio-chemistry A16, pathological physiology A18) and four pavilions for the Faculty of Science (chemistry A5, A8, A10, A12)
- A pavilion for the university campus central library (A9)
- A pavilion for bio – models (pavilion Z)
- Technical equipment and operational facilities



The whole Blue Stage was completed and opened in September 2007.

University Campus Library

- located in pavilion A9
- provides standard librarian, information and additional academic services for the Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Medicine
- total capacity including the underground storage areas is projected to hold over 500,000 items

Construction of Stages Yellow and Green

The construction began in 2007. The project includes:

- thirteen pavilions for the Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Medicine
- the pavilion and two gymnasiums for the Faculty of Sports Studies
- a teaching centre with large capacity, lecture halls and classrooms
- the whole construction is intended to be finished by the end of the year 2010

Incubator for Biomedical Technologies (INBIT)

- opened in 2005
- designed for start-up companies in the fields of medical, biotechnological and bio-informatics technologies



The Campus Square

- includes over 20,000 square meters of shopping area, with over 50 shops



The Faculty Hospital Brno

The Faculty Hospital Brno is the only hospital in Brno and all of Moravia which provides patients with basic, specialized and highly specialized care in all medical branches, regardless of the nature of the disease, severity of the accident or patient's age. It currently has 2 094 beds and more than 4500 employees.



It is also the largest teaching base for Masaryk University's Faculty of Medicine, enabling the education of paramedical staff and both pre- and post-graduate education for secondary school graduates and university graduates.
